##### A. Review of Opioid Settlement Funds Proposals:

- Clinton County received nine proposals for the County's Opioid Settlement funds;
- The requests total nearly \$1.65 million dollars, and there is approximately \$361,758 of funds available for the initial 18-month grant period;
- The Members reviewed and discussed the following proposals (members were asked to excuse themselves from voting if there is a conflict of interest):
  1. Bath Township Public Library (\$7,500)
  2. Clinton County Journey Court (\$70,410)
  3. Clinton County Veterans Treatment Court (\$70,410)
  4. CMHHA CEI Integrated Treatment and Recovery Services (\$121,702)
  5. Michigan Psychological Care Opioid Proposal (\$575,850)
  6. Positive Somebody and Cognitive Consultants (\$500,450)
  7. Recovery Worx (\$166,868)
  8. Trellis Marketing (\$60,000)
  9. Youturn Health (\$76,560)
- The following proposals were selected for further review and discussion at the next meeting:
  1. **Bath Township Public Library** – Liz Braddock will contact to clarify the safe needle disposal program and discuss possible partnership with another organization.
  2. **Clinton County Journey Court**
  3. **Clinton County Veterans Treatment Court** – Invite to next meeting to answer questions/concerns and discuss partial/modified award.
  4. **CMHHA CEI Integrated Treatment and Recovery Services** – Liz Braddock will inquire about the position of Peer Recovery Coach to confirm if they already have one on staff ready to start.
  5. **Recovery Worx** – Invite to next meeting to answer questions/concerns regarding transportation and building improvements and discuss partial/modified award.
- It is the goal of the Steering Committee to finalize their recommendation at the next meeting on Wednesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> and forward to the May 15<sup>th</sup> Ways and Means Committee Meeting for review and discussion;
- If the Ways and Means Committee is supportive of the recommendation, it could then be recommended for final approval at the May 27<sup>th</sup> Board of Commissioners meeting.
