RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE SUGGESTION THAT  
STATE FUNDING FOR MSU EXTENSION BE ELIMINATED

**WHEREAS**, MSU Extension in Clinton County provides 4-H programming for youth, assists the agricultural community, offers nutrition education, offers training about land use and planning laws and policies, along with providing many other services, and

**WHEREAS**, Clinton County provides \$260,000 in support of MSU Extension programming and their investment is coupled with state and federal appropriations, as well as grants, ensuring that the programming will meet the needs and interests of county residents, and

**WHEREAS**, the state currently provides \$28.6 million in funding for MSU Extension. Elimination of this funding would destroy this important educational network.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners oppose any suggestion that state funding for MSU Extension be eliminated.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that copies of this Resolution be sent the Governor Jennifer Granholm, Representative Scott Hummel, Representative Larry Julian, Senator Alan L. Cropsey, Speak of the House Rick Johnson and Senate Majority Leader Ken Sikkema.
