RESOLUTION 2017-22 DEACTIVATING THE CLINTON COUNTY BROWNFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR AN INDEFINITE PERIOD

WHEREAS, the County of Clinton created and provided for the operation of a Brownfield Redevelopment Authority for Clinton County pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of Act 381 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan of 1996, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's mission is the maintenance and implementation of a Brownfield Redevelopment Program through Clinton County, and to support the cleanup and redevelopment of environmentally contaminated, obsolete, functionally obsolete and previously used development sites that promote the economic goals of Clinton County; and

WHEREAS, since this time, several municipalities within our region have developed economic development/brownfield redevelopment partnerships and alliances that are already fulfilling these types of needs within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority has had unfilled vacancies that have been difficult to fill through the past several years; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners declares the deactivation of the Clinton County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority for an indefinite period;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners shall be responsible for recommending activation of brownfield redevelopment efforts in the future if deemed necessary.
