RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE STATE OF MICHIGAN TO PROVIDE THE STATE TAX COMMISSION/PROPERTY TAX DIVISION WITH THE STAFF AND RESOURCES TO ASSURE PROPER DETERMINATION OF THE ACCURACY OF PROPERTY VALUES

Moved by Commissioner Pierson and seconded by Commissioner Rademacher to approve the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the State Tax Commission/Property Tax Division oversees implementation of property tax legislation, provides guidance to local assessors and equalization departments in the form of policy and bulletins, and is a resource relied upon by local assessors in solving problems about property valuations and property taxes, and

WHEREAS, the State Tax Commission/Property Tax Division is not staffed with enough experts to assist assessors statewide,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Clinton County Board of Commissioners encourages the State of Michigan to provide its State Tax Commission/Property Tax Division adequate tools, resources and trained personnel to assure determination of the accuracy of values based upon fact.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be sent to Governor John Engler, Senator Mike Rogers, Representatives Larry Julian and Valde Garcia, the Senate Finance Committee, the House Taxation Policy Committee, the State Assessors Board, the State Tax Commission and all Michigan Counties.
