**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE TRI-COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING  
COMMISSION'S REGIONAL GROWTH:  
CHOICES FOR OUR FUTURE PROJECT AND APPLICATION TO THE  
FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission has initiated an innovative project, "Regional Growth: Choices for Our Future" to analyze the current and future pattern of growth in Clinton, Eaton and Ingham Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners is concerned about future impacts of growth on the County and local governments' ability to provide efficient services to its citizens, and

**WHEREAS**, the project will formulate consensus on a shared vision about a preferred alternative to the current growth trend; and

**WHEREAS**, specific tools, techniques and action strategies to implement the shared vision and preferred alternative will be developed as an outcome of this project;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners supports and endorses the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission's application for \$350,000 for the Federal Highway Administration's Transportation and Community Systems Preservation (TCSP) pilot program to be used for the "Regional Growth: Choices For Our Future" project.
