**RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE CLINTON COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION  
TO SET SPEED LIMITS ON GRAVEL AND OTHER UNPAVED ROADS**

**WHEREAS**, Clinton County has a high percentage of gravel and other unpaved roads; and

**WHEREAS**, a high percentage of road maintenance costs are spent to grade and gravel such unpaved roads; and

**WHEREAS**, the Clinton County Road Commission attributes much of the road deterioration and high maintenance costs of the county's unpaved roads to cars and trucks driving on these roads at excessive speeds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Clinton County Road Commission believes that road safety would be increased and maintenance and repair costs would be substantially reduced by restricting driving speeds on the unpaved roads in the county;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners hereby resolves to recommend to the Clinton County Road Commission that it take steps to have appropriate speed limits adopted for unpaved roads and to post speed limits for unpaved roads in Clinton County.
