RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CONSTRUCTION
OF AN INTERCHANGE AT I-69 AND CHANDLER ROAD
IN BATH TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, The Clinton County Board of Commissioners deems it to be in the best interest of, and beneficial to Clinton County to recommend the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) construct the proposed I-69 at Chandler Road interchange as discussed in countless public hearings prior to the construction of I-69 and as designed on plans filed with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation described in detail in the states, Final Environment Impact Study (FEIS) filed with Federal Highway Administration its intention to construct a future I-69/Chandler Road interchange upon local support and other technical information.

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration approved the FEIS, which included the future I-69/Chandler Road interchange, MDOT proceeded with design plans and the right-of-way acquisition according to these plans for the future interchange.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Michigan Department of Transportation, if necessary also coordinate with the local planning organization, to incorporate the I-69/Chandler Road interchange into the Michigan Department of Transportation's rolling "5 Year Road and Bridge Program".

The Michigan Department of Transportation construct the I-69/Chandler Road interchange at the earliest possible year to ensure safe traffic flow in and out of our community, avoid congestion and enhance the safety on our local road system.
