REVISED RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF PRISONER HOUSING REIMBURSEMENT POLICY AND PRISONER MEDICAL AND DENTAL REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan has adopted Acts 118 through 121 of the Public Acts of 1984, as amended by Public Act 212, 1994 which authorized the seeking of reimbursement from sentenced prisoners for the cost of maintenance and care not to exceed \$60.00 per day and cost of medical care, if authorized by the appropriate Board of Commissioners resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners and the Clinton County Sheriff believe it is in the interest of taxpayers of the County to seek from prisoners reimbursement for the cost of their maintenance and care and of medical and dental care when possible, and

WHEREAS, the daily cost of prisoner maintenance and care is in excess of **\$35.00** and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the following Medical and Dental Reimbursement Policy:

- a. Sick Call All inmates \$25.00 per visit - doctor
 All inmates \$10.00 per visit - nurse
- b. Medication All Inmates Actual Expenses
- c. Outside Medical All Inmates Actual Expenses
 and Dental
 Services including
 Hospitalization

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners does hereby approve seeking reimbursement from prisoners for the cost of their maintenance and care for their incarceration in the Clinton County Jail at the rate of **\$35.00** per day for sentenced inmates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this revised resolution will in into effect January 1, 1998.
