The following Preamble and Resolution were offered by Commissioner Pierson and supported by Commissioner Flood.

WHEREAS, Act 184 of the Public Acts of 1943, as amended (The Township Rural Zoning Act), allows the County Board of Commissioners to waive the provisions of Section 10 of said Act, which requires that the County Planning Commission review proposed amendments to township zoning ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Bath Charter Township Board of Trustees has requested that the County Board of Commissioners grant such a waiver; and

WHEREAS, the County Planning Commission has no objection to said request;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the County Board of Commissioners of the County of Clinton hereby waives the review of the Bath Charter Township Zoning Ordinance and all amendments to said Ordinance, with the understanding that this Resolution shall not prohibit the Township from obtaining informal assistance from either the County Planning Department or Planning Commission upon the Request of the Township.
