**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING HOURS
OF WORK TO RECEIVE
SERVICE CREDIT WITH M.E.R.S**

Whereas, the Municipal Employees Retirement System of Michigan Plan Document of 1996 requests a resolution of the governing body of each participating municipality to specify a day of work or the specified number of hours of work in a calendar month, and

Whereas, the Municipal Employees Retirement System of Michigan currently establishes a month of service credit as ten (10) eight (8) hour work days without receiving a resolution otherwise, and

Whereas, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners wish to establish the number of hours worked in a month to receive a month of credited service with M.E.R.S.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners establish eighty (80) hours worked per month as the defined hours of work to receive a month of service credit with M.E.R.S.
