**RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE CLINTON, EATON, INGHAM
COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH BOARD**

Introduced by the Finance Committee

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners has experienced problems and has concerns concerning the Clinton, Eaton, Ingham Community Mental Health (CMH) Board's current operations; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County and Eaton County are considering the possibility of disassociating from CMH and affiliating with a different Community Mental Health entity; and

WHEREAS, the Ingham County Board of Commissioners has requested a meeting to discuss these concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners is agreeable to such a meeting with such a meeting to be arranged by the Ingham County Controller; and

WHEREAS, CMH IS CURRENTLY CONSIDERING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW BUILDING.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this resolution puts Ingham County on notice that Clinton County and Eaton County are looking at alternate ways of providing mental health services to their residents and that construction of a new building should be put on hold until this issue is resolved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the meeting to discuss this issue will be held as soon as possible.
