RESOLUTION SETTING 1998 COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN COUNTY ELECTED OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners is responsible for setting the compensation levels for certain elected constitutional and statutory positions, namely the County Clerk, Treasurer, Register of Deeds, Sheriff, Prosecuting Attorney, and Drain Commissioner, and

WHEREAS, the Finance/Personnel Committee has proposed a 3% wage increase for 1998 for all employees who are not represented by a collective bargaining contract and has recommended this percentage increase be included the 1998 budget for the officials named above, and

WHEREAS, these elected officials have been afforded the same benefits as non-union employees as set forth in the Clinton County Personnel Manual, and the Finance Committee's 1998 budget recommendation includes the cost of providing those benefits as it has in the past.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 1998 compensation to be paid to the elected officials indicated below:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the elected officials shall continue to receive the same benefits as non-union employees as set forth in the Clinton County Personnel Manual.
