**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PROPOSED I-73 CORRIDOR PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the proposed I-73/74 interstate highway, which would run from Sault Saint Marie, Michigan to Toledo, Ohio, and on to Charleston, South Carolina, would include the portion of US-127 which lies in Clinton County, and

WHEREAS the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission contacted the County to assist them in determining the level of support for the project in Clinton County, and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners has requested that every city, township, and village council forward its position on the proposed I-73 corridor to the County, and

WHEREAS, the positions of all the responding local units has been unanimous in support of the project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners enthusiastically supports the inclusion of the US-127 bypass in the I-73 corridor project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution and the resolutions received from the local units of government in Clinton County be forwarded to the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission to assist them in their efforts to include I-73 Corridor through the State of Michigan.
