RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE EXECUTION
OF MID-SOUTH SUBSTANCE ABUSE COMMISSION
URBAN COOPERATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners at its meeting of September, 1996, authorized the consolidation of Capitol Area Substance Abuse Commission and the South Central Michigan Substance Abuse Commission as a separate legal entity under the Urban Cooperation Act and endorsed and supported the designation of the new entity as the substance abuse coordinating agency; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners at its September, 1996, meeting also authorized entering a joint agreement with eight (8) other participating counties in the new substance abuse coordinating agency; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Attorney General has suggested several modifications in the final Urban Cooperation Agreement, and the Board of Commissioners concurs with these changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the Urban Cooperation Agreement creating the Mid-South Substance Abuse Commission under the Urban Cooperation Act with the modifications suggested by the Michigan Attorney General.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson of the Board of Commissioners and the County Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the modified agreement.
