The following resolution was offered by <u>Commissioner Stacey</u> and seconded by <u>Commissioner Washburn</u>:

RESOLUTION 2018-13 PLEDGING FULL FAITH AND CREDIT REGARDING CARTER & BURKE AND BRANCHES DRAIN NOTES, SERIES 2018

WHEREAS, proceedings have been taken by the Clinton County Drain Commissioner for the construction of improvements to the Carter & Burke and Branches Drain (the "Project") under the provisions of Chapter 8 of the Drain Code of 1956, as amended, pursuant to a petition filed with the Drain Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, in order to defray the cost of the Project, the Drain Commissioner is expected to authorize and provide for the issuance by the Carter & Burke and Branches Drain Drainage District (the "Drainage District") of notes (the "Notes") in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$290,000 in anticipation of the collection of an equal amount of special assessments against property and public corporations (including the County of Clinton) in the Drainage District, said special assessments to be duly confirmed by the Drain Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the Notes are to be designated "Carter & Burke and Branches Drain Notes, Series 2018," will bear interest at a rate of not to exceed 5.0% per annum and will mature no later than June 1, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the Drain Commissioner deems it advisable and necessary to obtain from this Board a resolution consenting to the pledge of the full faith and credit of the County on the Notes; and

WHEREAS, the Project is necessary to protect and preserve the public health and therefore it is in the best interest of the County of Clinton that the Notes be sold.

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF

CLINTON:

1. Pursuant to the authorization provided in Section 434 of the Drain Code of 1956, as amended,

provided that the Notes are issued within the parameters set forth above, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners,

by a 2/3 vote of its members elect, does hereby irrevocably pledge the full faith and credit of the County of Clinton for

the prompt payment of the principal of and interest on the Notes, and does agree that in the event that the property

owners or public corporations in the Drainage District shall fail or neglect to account to the County Treasurer of the

County of Clinton for the amount of any special assessment installment and interest, when due, then the amount thereof

shall be immediately advanced from County funds, and the County Treasurer is directed to immediately make such

advancement to the extent necessary.

2. In the event that, pursuant to said pledge of full faith and credit, the County of Clinton advances out of

County funds, all or any part of said installment and interest, it shall be the duty of the County Treasurer, for and on

behalf of the County of Clinton, to take all actions and proceedings and pursue all remedies permitted or authorized by

law for the reimbursement of such sums so paid.

3. All resolutions and parts of resolutions, insofar as the same may be in conflict with the provisions of

this resolution, be and the same hereby are rescinded.
