RESOLUTION 2019 – 11 **RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2005-38** **ESTABLISHING FEES FOR IDENTIFIED** **DIGITAL INFORMATION IN TREASURER’S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the “Enhanced Access to Public Records Act” Act 462 of the Public Acts of 1996 the County adopted an Enhanced Access to Public Records Policy in August of 2003;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that certain parcel record information maintained by the County Treasurer may be made available through the enhanced access system; and

WHEREAS, it is permissible to charge a reasonable fee for data made available via enhanced access; and

WHEREAS, resolution 2005-38 established certain fees for identified digital information in the Treasurer’s Offices; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that billing according to statute more accurately conforms to the generally accepted practice of other county treasurer offices throughout the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the rescission of Resolution 2005-38 will permit the County Treasurer to establish fees in accordance with MCL 48.101 for the identified digital information in the Treasurer’s office:

Excerpts from database – disk/CD*	
Per Parcel/Record	\$0.50 plus postage
Excerpts from database – hard copy*	
Per Parcel/Record	\$0.50 plus postage

*Fees to be paid in advance. Fees may be waived upon signing of an affidavit stating that the data is to be used for educational purposes only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Treasurer is hereby authorized to adjust fees pursuant to any rate change authorized by future statute amendments, without further board action.
