## **RESOLUTION 2006-18** **AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE FEDERALLY MANDATED REGIONALIZATION OF** **HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE CLINTON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES** **DEPARTMENT AND LOCAL PLANNING TEAM. (LPT)**

**WHEREAS**, the Clinton County Emergency Services Coordinator, Local Planning Team and Public Safety Officials are hereby requesting the Clinton County Board of Commissioners to adopt the Regionalization of Homeland Security, as approved by the Michigan Homeland Security Protection Board on February 16, 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the President in Homeland Security Directive (HSPD) 8, directed the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to develop a National Preparedness Goal to strengthen the preparedness of the United States to prevent, respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks, major disasters, and other emergencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Homeland Security has developed the National Preparedness Goal which establishes a vision for a National Preparedness System; and establishes seven National Priorities; one of which is **expanded regional collaboration**, in order to enhance coordinated development of capabilities; and, achieving the vision for the National Preparedness Goal depends upon regional collaboration; and,

**WHEREAS**, the State of Michigan has adopted the National Priorities, including regional collaboration, to implement Homeland Security; and,

**WHEREAS**, Clinton County has been designated as being located within State Homeland Security Region One; sharing regional Homeland Security with the Counties of Eaton, Ingham, Gratiot, Hillsdale, Jackson, Lenawee, Livingston and Shiawassee; and

**WHEREAS**, Clinton County is committed to providing for the safety of all first responders and citizens within the County, and does hereby support the Regionalization of the Homeland Security Program; and,

**WHEREAS**, Clinton County does hereby support this National Priority by providing representation through a primary and alternate representative elected by, and from, the County's Local Planning Team of record to the Regional Homeland Security Board, Region One; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 31, 2006, Steven L. Lehman was elected by the Local Planning Team to serve as the County's Primary Representative and Larry E. Martin, as the Alternate Representative.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the County Emergency Services Coordinator and the Local Planning Team (LPT), to participate in this grant program and in support of the Federally Mandated Regional Structure as approved by the State of Michigan Homeland Security Protection Board on February 16, 2006.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Board Chairperson, County Financial Officer and Emergency Services Coordinator be authorized to sign any agreements and other documents required by the State of Michigan, Federal Government, and the First District Regional Board.
