Resolution 2012 – 3

Recreation Passport Grant Application – Motz County Park Vault Toilet & Landscaping

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Parks and Green Space Commission has prepared a Recreation Passport Grant application to cost-share the construction of a vault toilet and landscape improvements at Motz County Park; and

WHEREAS, Motz County Park experiences 70,000 annual visits, including visitors who use the park during cold weather months to ice fish and walk the lake trail for health and fitness; and

WHEREAS, the provision of an all-season vault toilet is needed to serve visitors from October through mid-May when the park's full-service beach house is closed for use; and

WHEREAS, planting of long-lived deciduous trees in the picnic grounds is needed to provide visitors with cooling shade and protection from the negative health effects of over-exposure to direct sunlight; and

WHEREAS, the Green Space Commission has requested Clinton County Board of Commissioners approval of the aforementioned grant application; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners (Board) does hereby approve submittal of the *Motz County Park Vault Toilet and Landscaping* Recreation Passport Grant application to the Department of Natural Resources and authorizes its Chairperson Robert E. Showers to sign application documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon approval of the grant application, the Board commits to financing the *Motz County Park Vault Toilet and Landscaping* project, as specified in the Recreation Passport Grant application, including a local match of \$6,700 representing 45% of the total project cost of \$14,900.
