Complete and mail/email this bingo card **by 4 p.m. on Friday, December 11, 2020**, to be **eligible to receive a free, reusable compact straw AND be entered in a drawing to win a tumbling composting bin**. Available to Clinton County residents only.

Directions

1. Each time you complete a square cross it off.
2. Get bingo by marking five in a row: vertically, horizontally or diagonally.
3. Send us proof of your completed card in **one** of these ways:
 - ⇒ Take a photo and email it to conserve@clinton-county.org
 - ⇒ Mail your completed card to Clinton County Department of Waste Management, 100 E. State St. Suite 1500 St Johns, MI 48879
 - ⇒ Take a picture of your completed card and send us a message on the Clinton County Facebook page.
4. Include your name, address, phone number and/or email. This information is needed to mail you a straw and contact you if you win the composting bin.
